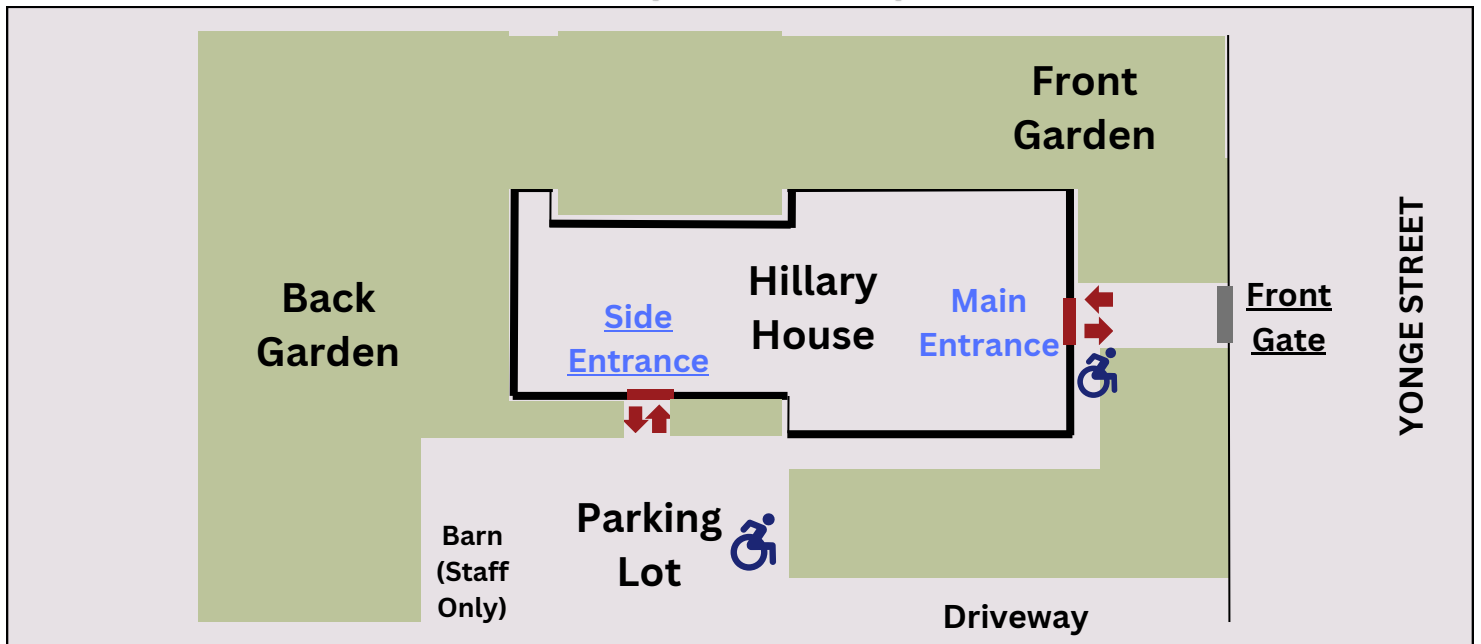
## Accessibility Initiatives

# Interior Accessibility Floor Plan

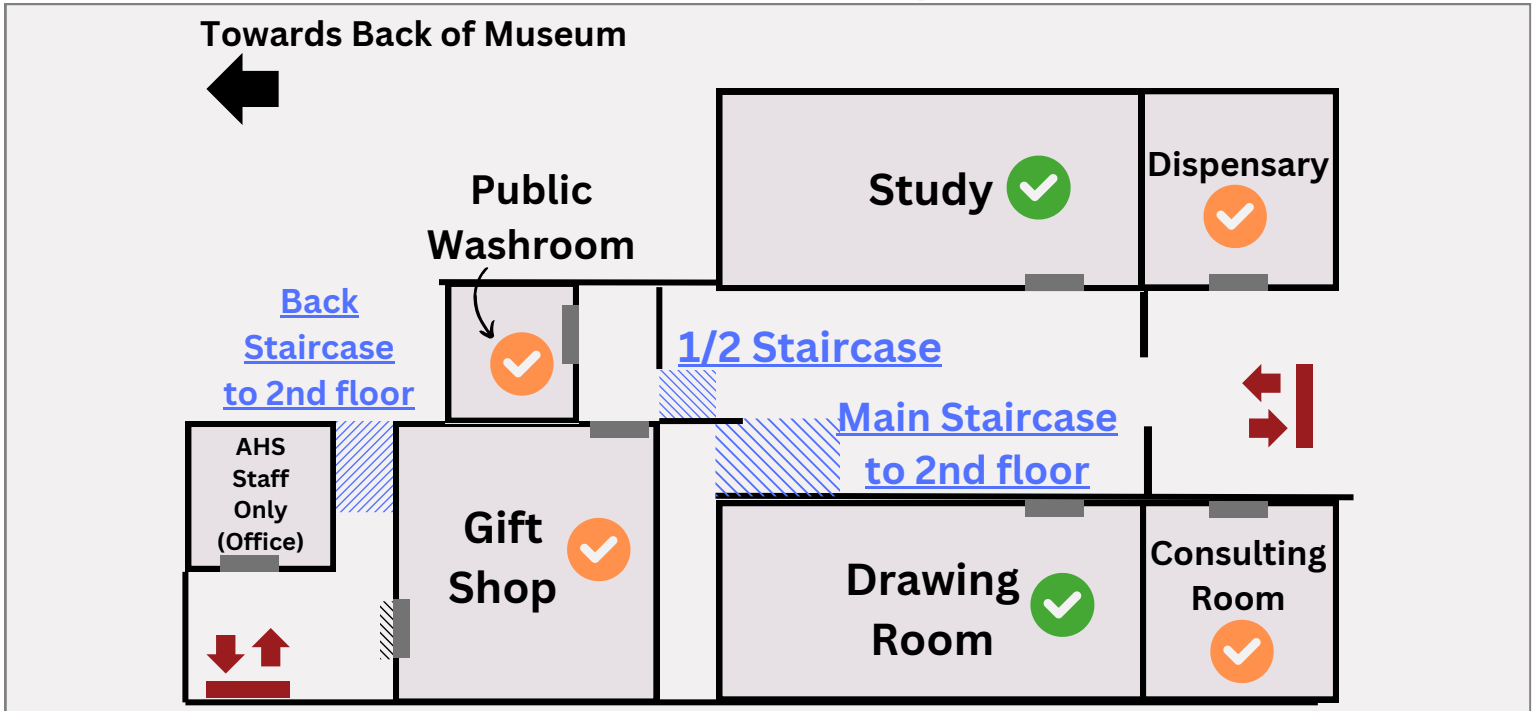

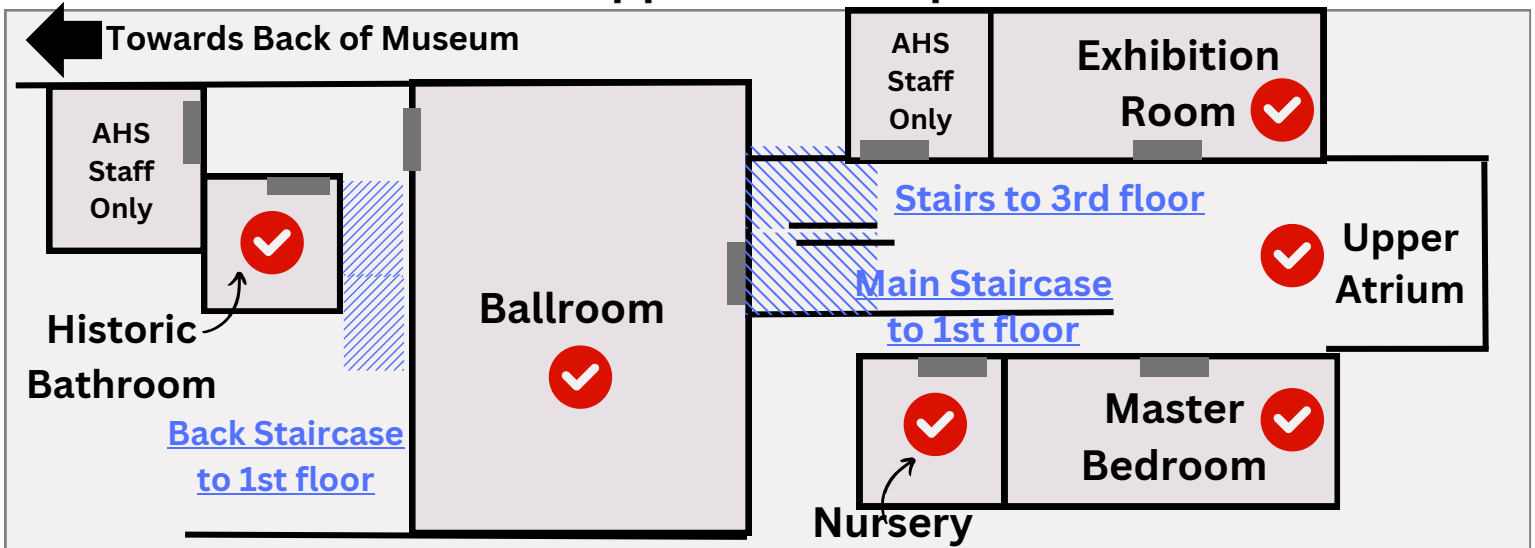

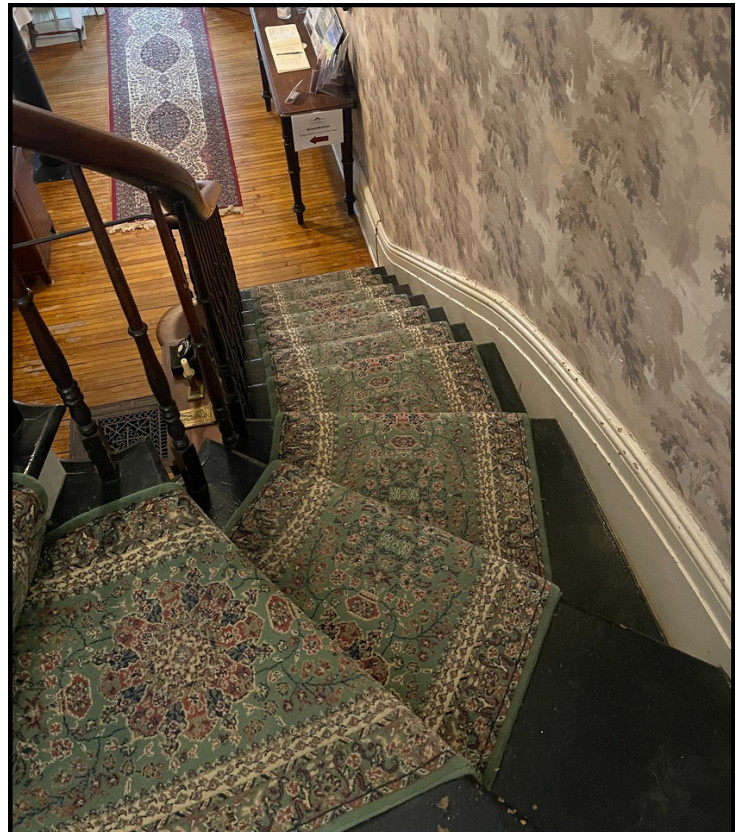
